2- WORKSHOP *Cleaning of stone monuments*

The course will introduce the issues of stone cleaning in terms of philosophy, restoration ethics and conceptual approach.

It will also describe the main types of dirt its sources and mechanisms of deposition on the surface of stone depending on the exposure of the object and the type of material.

Participants will be introduced to current cleaning methods, their principles, and the possibilities and limits of their use, including the potential risks associated with cleaning.



They will learn about the methods of objective assessment of the cleaning process and the outcome.

The course combines theoretical lectures and practical

demonstrations of cleaning methods (different types of laser cleaning, micro-abrasive methods, chemical cleaning, systems using water or steam, etc.) and evaluation of cleaning tests (in situ microscopy, electron microscopy, microscopy of samples, water absorption measurements, etc.).

The programme will be delivered in English.
